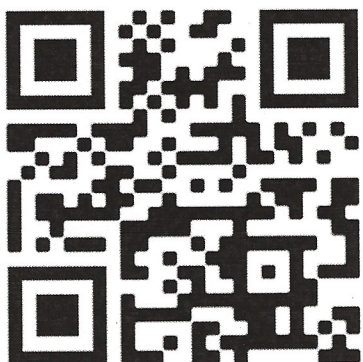

One of the areas to be cleaned will be the classrooms, storage rooms, closets, bathrooms and hallways of the old Educational Building – both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors.
