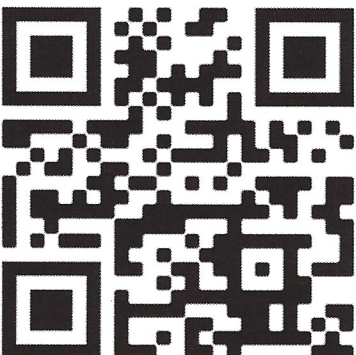
Decorating for Christmas: Would you like to help with Christmas decorations? We will decorate Nov 28-Dec 2. Watch for further announcements.
