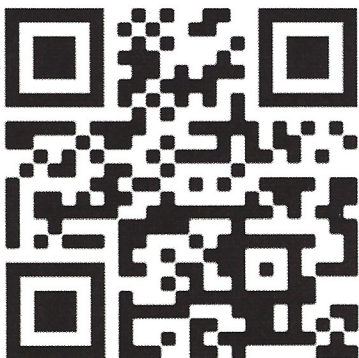

Answer: The rule which God at first revealed to man for his obedience was the moral law.

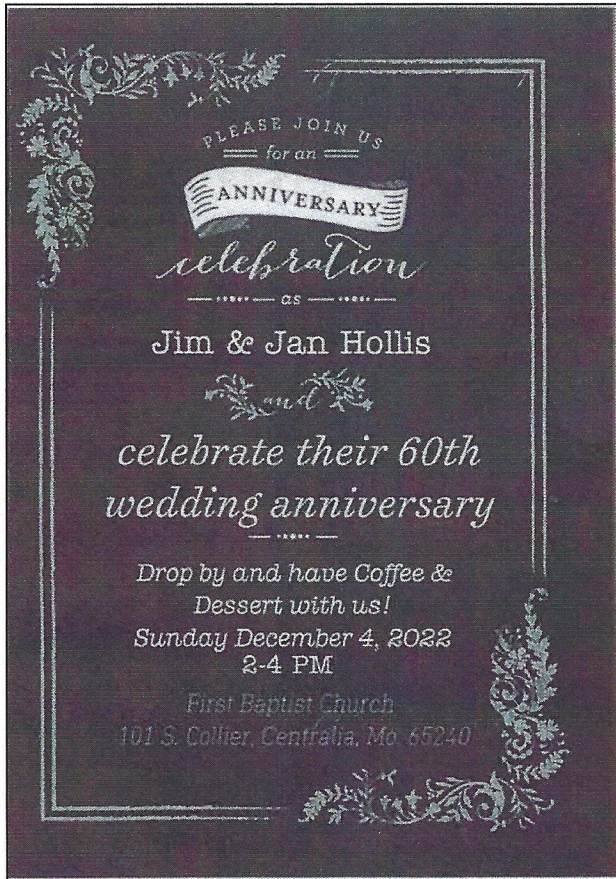
