**Open Pickleball:** Weekly beginning March 3 at 6:00pm in the FBC gym.

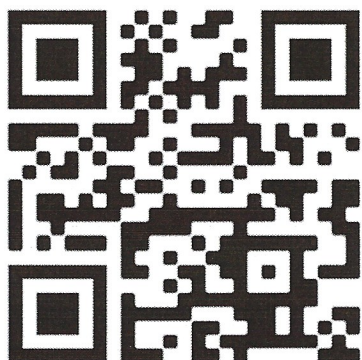
