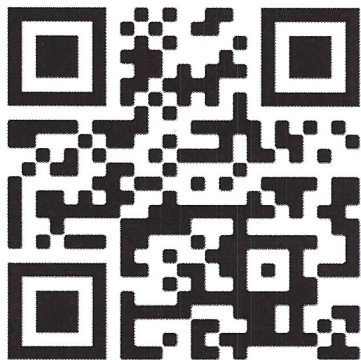
Needs for Community Pantry: Shampoo, Bar Soap, Kleenex
