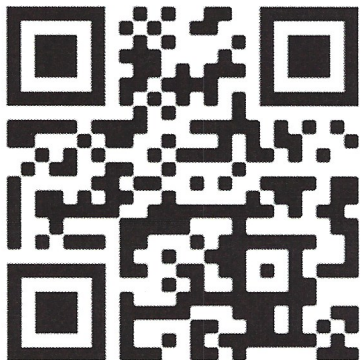

#### FBCB Bulletin 11June2023

- Following are some of the details of the 2023 Amazonia Mission Trip.
  - Expected dates of travel to Amazonia are November 3 through November 15, 2023.
    - We will fly into Manaus, a large city on the Amazon River in the northern part of Brazil and probably stay one night in Manaus.
    - From Manaus we will travel by a smaller commercial plane to São Gabriel da Cachoeira (SGC). The flights to and from SGC are only scheduled on limited days, one or two flights each week.
    - SGC will be the base of our mission work and we will travel by small boat (possibly up to four hours, one way) on the Rio Negro to villages on the river.
    - While in the villages we will share the gospel with indigenous people living there. We will stay in the villages while working, sleeping in sleeping bags or hammocks.
    - Dirlene asked us to remember, it's a native people in the Amazon forest ... so, it will be a rainforest environment with animals, mosquitos, etc.
    - Travel on the river will be by the boat FBCB purchased for Pastor Marcos.
    - The return trip will again be by smaller commercial plane from SGC to Manaus and return flight from Manaus to the USA.
  - Travel to Brazil will require a current USA passport.
  - Travel to the villages on the Rio Negro will be into a reservation and will require an invitation from the tribal leaders.
  - Travel into the northern states of Brazil will require vaccinations for Yellow Fever, Malaria, COVID, Hepatitis, etc.
