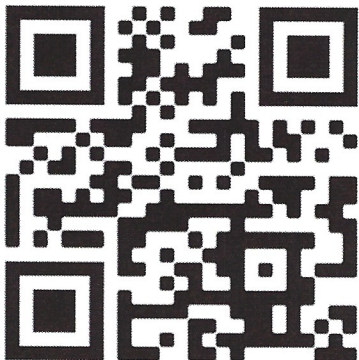

The mission work to Amazonia (Brazil) in November will partner with a full time missionary pastor in the City of São Gabriel da Cachoeira, Pastor José Marcos. Pr. Marcos is originally from Rio de Janeiro, and now he and his wife serve in a small Baptist church in São Gabriel da Cachoeira where he reaches out to indigenous people in Amazonia who live in villages along the Rio Negro, a main tributary river of the Amazon River. (FBC-Centralia purchased a boat and motor last year for Pr. Marcos to use in his ministry.)
