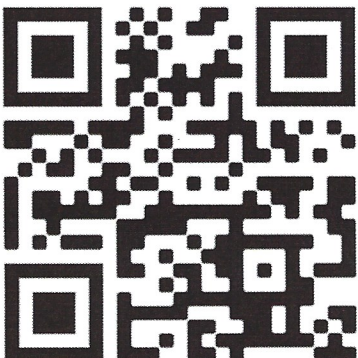
FBC Kids Leadership Team Needs
