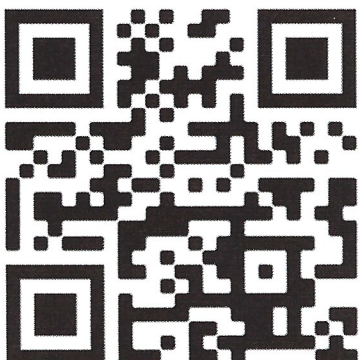
Helpers Needed in the Children's Dept: Please let Nicole Rhoades know if you can serve. Nursery workers and Children's Church helpers

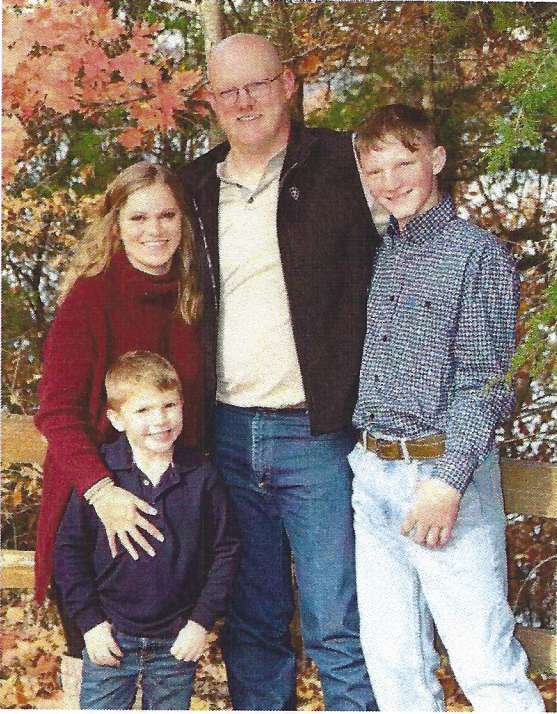
