The FBC Scholarship applications are available online and in the church office. The deadline for submission is April 1. <https://www.centraliafbc.org/scholarship-application>

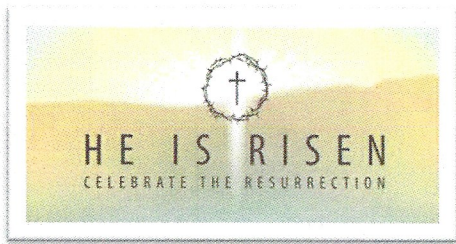

A container for your donations will be by the food pantry basket in the fellowship foyer. Thank you.

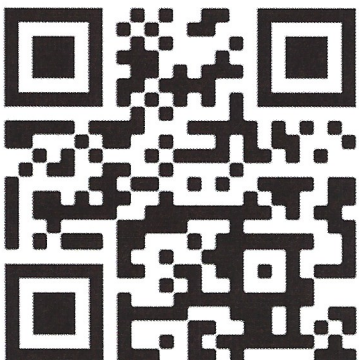

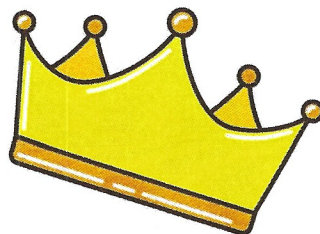
