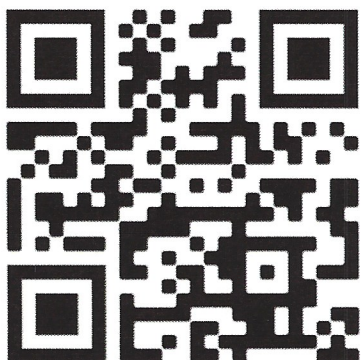
The FBC Scholarship applications are available online or in the church office. The deadline for submission is April 1.

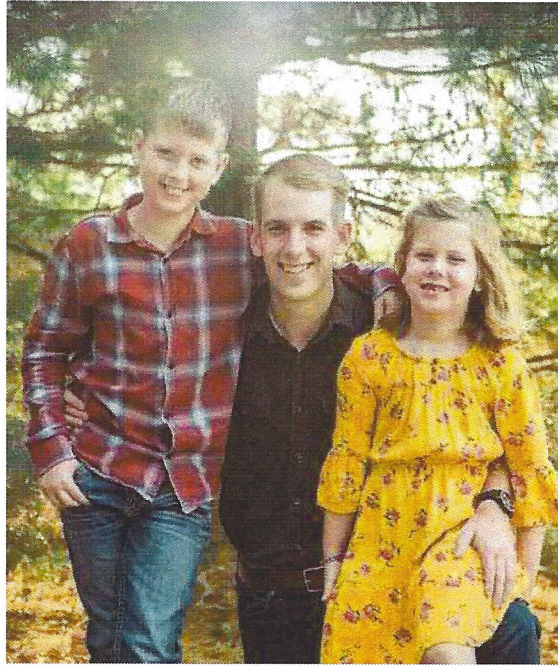
