**The Chronicles Committee** (history committee) is seeking your help! We are gathering all information about the church history beginning with the year 1993-current.

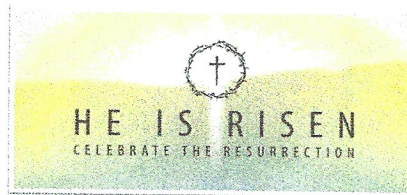

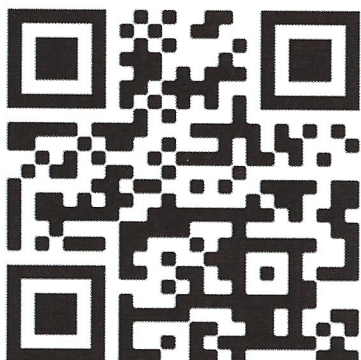
