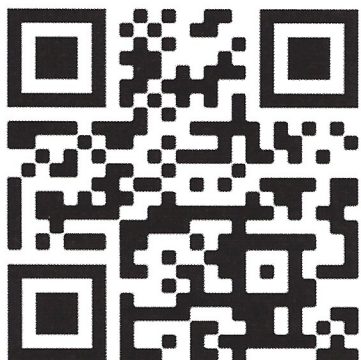
The **FBC Scholarship Application** deadline is about 3 weeks away. The scholarship information can be found under the resources tab on our website. [Deadline is April 1.](#)
