Brazil Opportunity: Our ministry partners in Brazil recently made us aware of an urgent need. A church in Serra Talhada is very involved in mission outreach. They have partnered with Compassion International to operate two ministry centers near their city and are in the process of opening a third. Part of the project requires a piece of property for outdoor recreation. This project will cost R\$40.000 in Brazilian currency (approx. \$8400). They made a down payment and will pay the balance in installments. At our Sunday Members meeting, our church family elected to send at least \$1000 (approx. R\$4.800 in Brazilian currency) to assist with the down payment.
