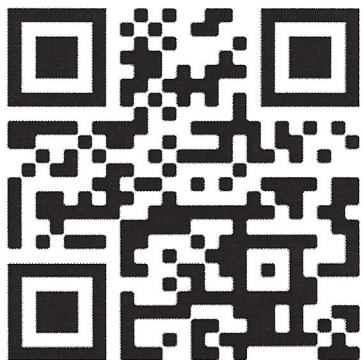

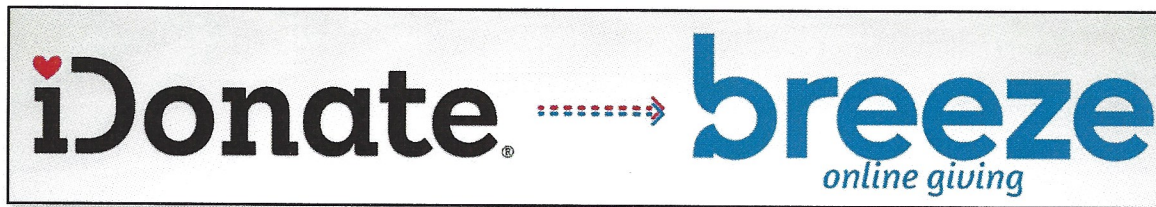
Nursery is available during our worship gathering for children from birth through preschool. The nursery is located up the stairs from the family entrance. Ushers are available to help with the nursery check-in process.

Children's Church is available for children in kindergarten through the third grade on the first three Sundays of each month. Children's Church is dismissed from the Sanctuary before the sermon begins.

BRAZIL MISSION PROJECT

Our ministry partners in Brazil recently made us aware of an urgent need. A church in Serra Talhada is very involved in mission outreach. They have partnered with Compassion International to operate two ministry centers near their city and are in the process of opening a third. Part of the project requires a piece of property for outdoor recreation. This project will cost R\$40.000 in Brazilian currency (approx. \$8400). They made a down payment and will pay the balance in installments. At our Sunday Members meeting, our church family elected to send at least \$1000 (approx. R\$4.800 in Brazilian currency) to assist with the down payment. MORE OPPORTUNITIES WITH *BREEZE*

Have you heard about *Breeze*, our online communication/membership program? Since the initiation of the program in 2020, it has proved to be a very useful tool to many in the congregation. If you haven't tried it, contact the church office for more information.

If you are already on *Breeze*, here's one more reason to love it. On July 1 we will change our online offerings company from iDonate to the *Breeze* program. There should be no extra effort from the ones that already do online offerings. You can still do recurring offerings. Currently through iDonate, you can only choose General fund; with *Breeze* you will have designated fund options.

Going through *Breeze* for online offerings will save FBC \$75 per month. When entering your offerings through the FBC website (centraliafbc.org), you will have a chance to choose whether you or the church pays the fees. If you choose to pay the fees, you will get credit for those on your givings record.

Fees:

Debit Card: 1% + 25c per transaction

Credit Card: 2.9% + 30c per transaction
