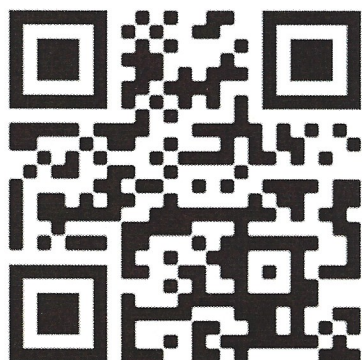
NEWS
