

#### **Montana Partnership**

The Missions Committee will include in their 2022 budget proposal a partnership with Apsaalooke Baptist Church in Crow Agency, Montana. This is part of the Missouri Baptist Convention's partnership initiative with Montana Baptist churches. Apsaalooke Baptist is a small church on the Crow Indian Reservation. Our church looks to come alongside Apsaalooke Baptist to encourage, support, and further their mission of making disciples in their region. We tentatively plan to send a short-term team to support the ministry of Apsaalooke Baptist from July 29-August 7, 2022. Full details and registration info will be available in early January 2022.
