### SERMON NOTES

**TEXT: ROMANS 3:1-20 (CSB)**

*3:1 So what advantage does the Jew have? Or what is the benefit of circumcision? 2 Considerable in every way. First, they were entrusted with the very words of God. 3 What then? If some were unfaithful, will their unfaithfulness nullify God's faithfulness? 4 Absolutely not! Let God be true, even though everyone is a liar, as it is written:*

*That you may be justified in your words  
and triumph when you judge.*

*5 But if our unrighteousness highlights God's righteousness, what are we to say? I am using a human argument: Is God unrighteous to inflict wrath? 6 Absolutely not! Otherwise, how will God judge the world? 7 But if by my lie God's truth abounds to his glory, why am I also still being judged as a sinner? 8 And why not say, just as some people slanderously claim we say, "Let us do what is evil so that good may come"? Their condemnation is deserved!*

*9 What then? Are we any better off? Not at all! For we have already charged that both Jews and Gentiles are all under sin, 10 as it is written:*

*There is no one righteous, not even one.*

*11 There is no one who understands;  
there is no one who seeks God.*

*12 All have turned away;  
all alike have become worthless.*

*There is no one who does what is good,  
not even one.*

*13 Their throat is an open grave;  
they deceive with their tongues.*

*Vipers' venom is under their lips.*

*14 Their mouth is full of cursing and bitterness.*

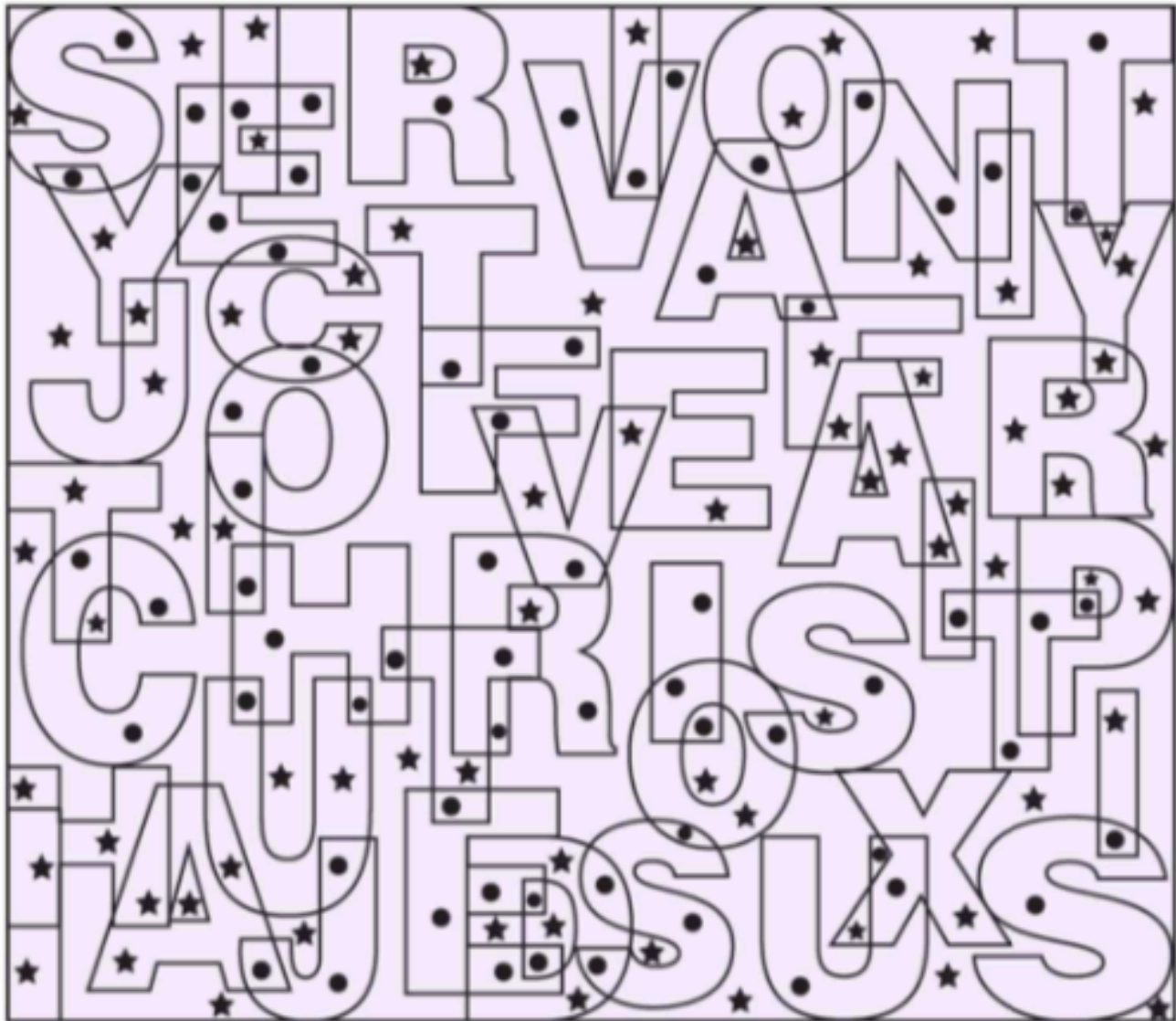

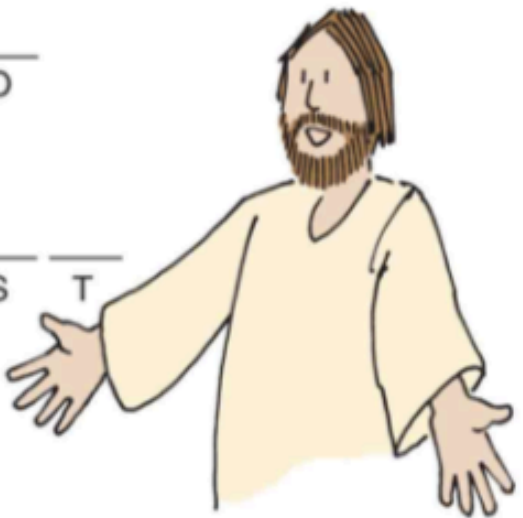

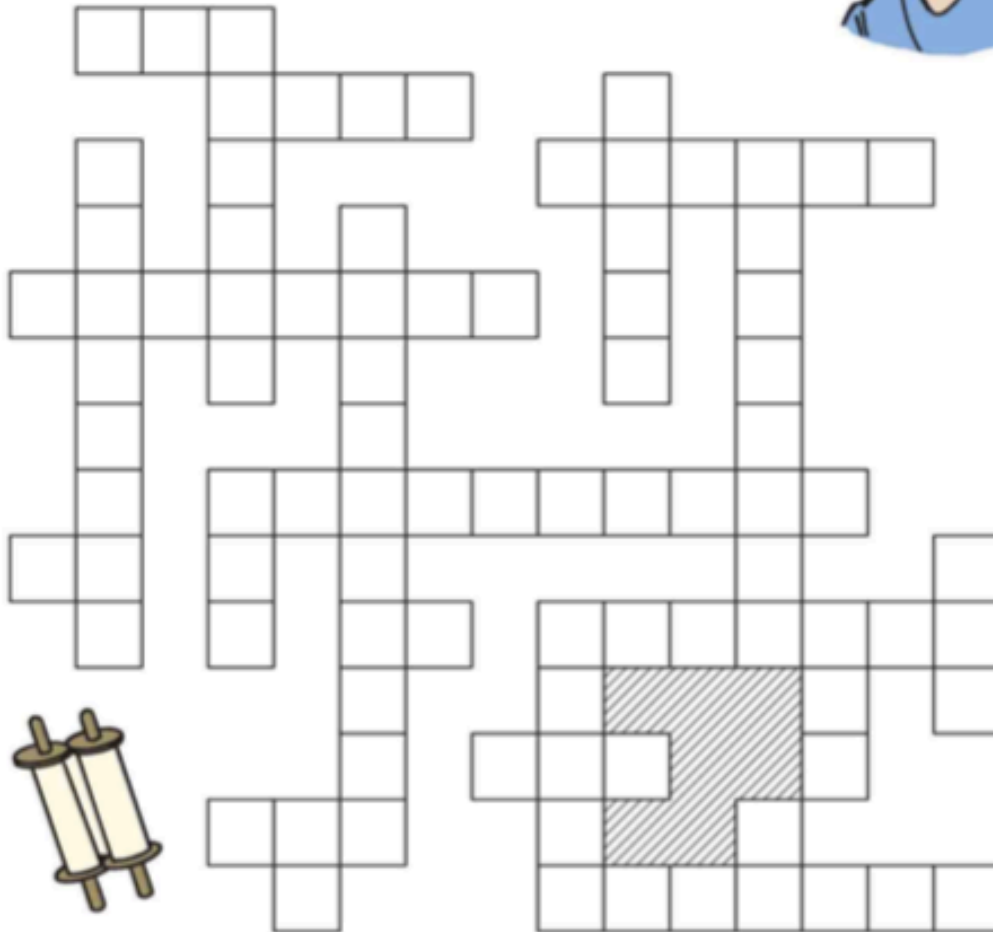
