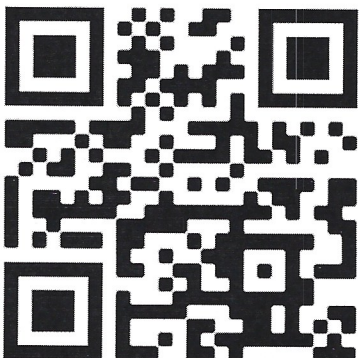
The Building Study Committee [invites the FBC Family](#) to join them for a planning session and survey on March 20 immediately following the Member's Meeting. We'll discuss various areas of our facility and are excited to hear your thoughts about how we can steward our property in the days ahead.

The deacons will bring the following recommendations at our March 20 Members Meeting:

Motion #1: The deacons recommend FBC of Centralia authorizes the Property Committee to expend up to \$7,000 for black mold abatement.

Motion #2: The deacons recommend FBC of Centralia authorizes the Property Committee to expend up to \$75,000 for tuck pointing. Funds will be taken from the Mansfield CD.

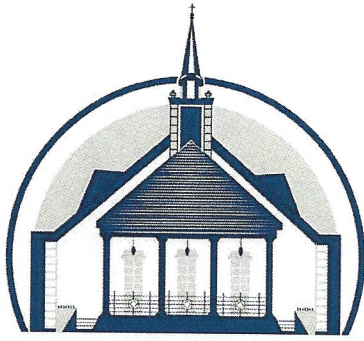

Dear Parents,

We have some new families, so I would like to take a moment to review our policies.

1. Teachers will be in their classrooms by 8:50. Please do not send your child(ren) to class before 8:50.
2. We have a check in/check out process. We will check your child(ren) in at the bottom of the stairs. From there, your child(ren) will go to class and you may go to your class.
3. At the end of Sunday School, please come back to the table at the bottom of the stairs to check your child(ren) out. We will call them and they will come down. Do not go to your child's classroom to pick them up.
4. If your child(ren) attends the nursery during service, we will walk them to the nursery and you can pick them up after service. The only exception to this is if you have a child in the infant nursery. You may drop off and pick up babies from the nursery. If someone other than you will be picking your child(ren) up, please advise when you drop them off.

We will be working on a schedule of activities for the upcoming year. Please be on the lookout for those.
