Martha's One Hour Rolls

Dissolve one package of yeast into 1/4 cup of lukewarm water and let stand 2-3 minutes. To 1/2 cup canned milk, Milk add hot water to make 1 cup lukewarm liquid. Add 1 1/2 teaspoons of sugar, half teaspoon of salt, two large tablespoons vegetable (Wesson) oil and 2 1/2 cups flour. Mix into a soft dough. Work with flour and let rise 20 minutes. Make rolls with oiled hands and let rise 20 minutes. Bake 10 minutes at 450°.
