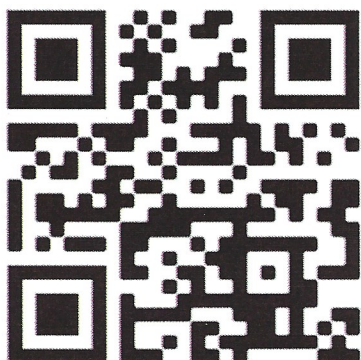

CALLED SPECIAL BUSINESS MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT

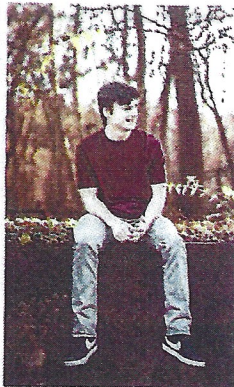
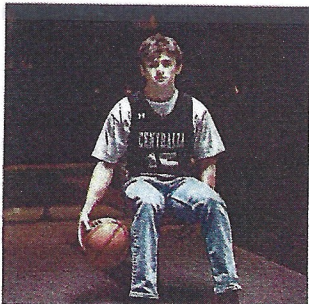
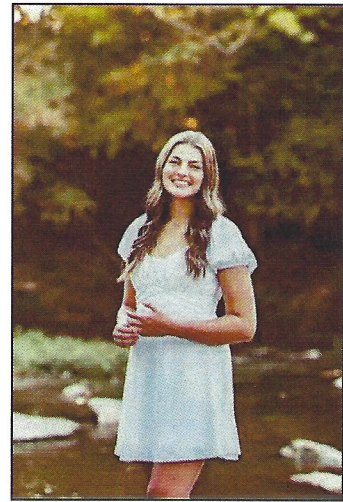
DATE: May 5, 2024 (TODAY), following morning worship service.
